### FEES

The Basic Membership Fee\* includes BDI insurance\*\* for up to 3 colonies / nucs and must be paid by all members whether or not they keep bees. BDI insurance is only valid if all colonies are insured. Note also that running two queens in a hive counts as two colonies. After the 31<sup>st</sup> March, 40 days must elapse from the date of membership or the payment of additional premium before cover is valid.

\* **Membership Fee** - £8.00 of your membership fee is paid to the Welsh Beekeepers' Association (WBKA) where it is used to publish the Welsh Beekeeper Magazine, pay the Third Party and Product Liability Insurance Premium with a small margin for other WBKA operating costs. A further £2.00 of all basic membership fees goes to BDI.

\*\* **BDI Insurance** - Provides compensation towards the cost of frames and foundation following destruction under a Bee Destruction Order issued by a Ministry inspector. All colonies must be insured at the time of the inspection for a claim to be considered by BDI. Please ensure you have sufficient cover at all times during the year. Contact the membership secretary to pay the additional premium before adding colonies. Payments made after 31<sup>st</sup> March will not be operative for insurance purposes until 40 days after the payment date.

**Data Protection:-** Pembrokeshire Beekeepers' Association use this information to maintain our own membership records. We pass relevant information to BDI Insurance, Welsh Beekeepers' Association and the Regional Bee Inspection Service operated by FERA. We do not pass your information to anyone else.
